Settings & Coin Inhibiting Guide for the NRI G13.mft/4 Coin Acceptor from 08/2004

On the rear of the coin acceptor are two banks of 10 DIL switches - S1.1-10 and S2.1-10, as shown in fig. 1

The first 8 switches on each bank can be used to inhibit or enable the acceptance of individual coins or tokens, switches 9 and 10 are not used for inhibiting coins. All coins and tokens are enabled as default (all switches in the OFF position)

To inhibit the acceptance of an individual coin the corresponding switches for the coin must be in the ON (upwards) position.
